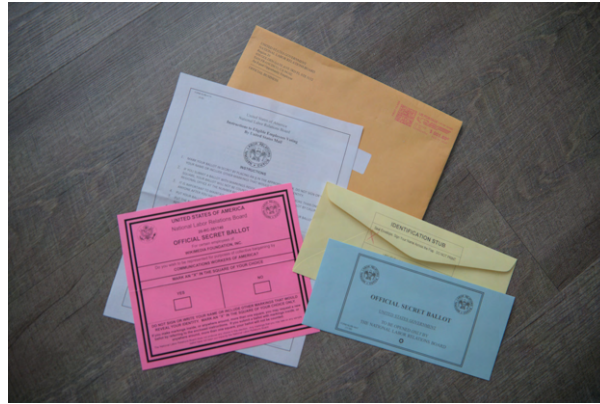


How to Vote. (With Pictures!)

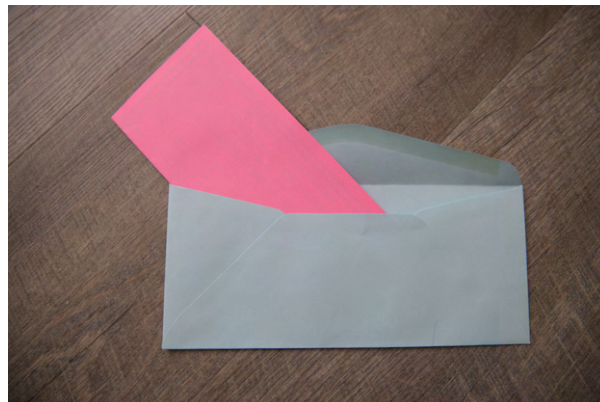
When you get your voter kit, it will have all of these items in it:



- The large brown envelope contains everything else.
- The white paper is the voting instructions.
- The pink/red square is the ballot.
- The blue envelope is for the ballot.
- The yellow envelope is for the blue envelope.

First, get a pen or pencil and fill in the ballot: **ONLY MARK ONE SQUARE**, do not put any other marks anywhere else on the ballot. Do not put initials or your name anywhere on the ballot. Just one X in the box!

Second, fold the ballot in half and put it in the blue envelope.



Seal the blue envelope. Don't write on it.



Third, put the sealed blue envelope into the yellow envelope.



Seal the yellow envelope.

Fourth, sign the yellow envelope on the back, over the sealed part.



SIGN it, don't print the name.

The yellow envelope will already have postage on it; this should be all you need, at least for the United States.

And, finally, take it to the post office and put it right in the box. And take a selfie, DO NOT show the signature side of the envelope. Show the other side!



That is it, you're done! Wait 2-3 days and then start calling the NLRB (415-356-5130, SF regional office) to see if your vote was received. Then join the watch party on September 3rd (details to be announced) to see the votes counted in real time!
